“Stuck in a Moment” DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. (From Bill Hybels' *Walk Across The Room*) In John 8, when Christ encounters the woman who had been caught in adultery, he immediately reflects God's compassion, gentleness, and love. Does this picture mesh with who you know God to be? Why or why not?
2. Isaiah saw God, and it freaked Him out. Do we have a similar response to Isaiah, or are we looking at our own projections of God instead of seeing Him as He really is? If we haven't freaked in that way, why might that keep us from sharing the good news?
3. What do you get the most passionate about in conversation? Is that what takes a primary place in your heart? Is there room in your heart for the things Jesus was passionate about? What do you want your heart to be filled with?
4. In your own words, describe the viewpoint and behavior of a 'First Amendment Christian', a believer who wants to express their belief to the fullest. Contrast with a 'Fifth Amendment Christian', a believer who wants to avoid looking bad or being judged by others.
5. Paul wrote Timothy "Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season". Are you preaching the word? Are you always prepared, in every situation? How can you prepare to be better prepared?
6. Paul says, in 1 Corinthians 1:21, "For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe." What do you think is the foolishness Paul refers to?
